1. Pursuant to Labor Law Section 101 and Part 66 of the Board's Rules of Procedure and Practice (Rules), on January 21, 2009, the Petitioners commenced the above proceeding by filing a petition for review of the Orders that Respondent Commissioner of Labor (Commissioner) issued on December 22, 2008 against the Petitioners; and
2. The Commissioner filed an answer to the petition on March 3, 2009; and
3. By letter from counsel for the Department of Labor dated June 22, 2009, the Board was informed that the Order to Comply on review in this proceeding was paid in full; and
4. By letter dated June 22, 2009, the Board requested that Petitioners advise the Board by July 22, 2009, whether or not they intended to proceed with the appeal challenging the Commissioner's orders and stated that if there were no response by July 22, 2009, the


5. Board would assume that they had no further interest in proceeding with the appeal and that they have withdrawn their petition; and
6. The Board, having received no further correspondence from Petitioners, finds that further review of the Orders here is unnecessary, and that the proceeding should be discontinued.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:


The above proceeding be, and the same hereby is, discontinued in accordance with the Board's Rules.
