WHEREAS:


1. An application having been made for approval of a proposed Certificate of Incorporation, on April 19, 2013, in the above entitled matter; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT


1. The said Certificate of Incorporation is approved; and
