**WHEREAS:**

1. The above proceeding was commenced by the filing of a petition for review pursuant to Labor Law § 101 and Part 66 of the Industrial Board of Appeals Rules of Procedure and Practice (12 NYCRR Part 66) on November 12, 2014, seeking to review an order issued by the respondent Commissioner of Labor against petitioner; and
2. The petition is deficient because the order or orders to be reviewed is or are not attached as required by Board Rule 66.3 (d); and
3. By letter dated June 29, 2015, the Board notified petitioner at the address provided in the petition, that he must file an amended petition that conforms with Board Rule 66.3 by July 29, 2015, or the petition may be dismissed without further notice; and
4. The June 29, 2015 letter was returned by the U. S. Postal Service as “return to sender/unable to forward”; and
5. Board Rule 65.4 requires that any change in a party’s contact information be communicated to the Board in writing promptly; and
6. The Board has not received any communications from petitioner that his contact information has changed; and
7. Pursuant to Board Rule 65.14, “the failure to file any pleading pursuant to these rules when due may . . . constitute a waiver of the right to further participation in the proceeding;” and


8. Petitioner has not filed an amended petition as directed by the Board; and

The petition for review be, and the same hereby is, dismissed in accordance with the Board's Rules.




