


why she was unavailable to attend the July 29, 2015 hearing. Respondent was given until April 1, 2016 to file a response to petitioners' motion for reconsideration. On March 14, 2016, Molina submitted a copy of her passport verifying that she was out of the country from June 12 through August 8, 2015, to substantiate her position that she was out of the country for a family emergency on July 29, 2015, and was unable to attend the hearing. She also provided medical documentation showing that she was injured on the job in a motor vehicle accident on August 21, 2015, which resulted in a concussion and spinal injury. Respondent did not file a response.

We find that petitioners have provided sufficient documentation to support their motion for reconsideration, and we revoke our September 16, 2015 decision dismissing the petition. A new hearing in this matter will be scheduled on a date to be determined.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:
