## WHEREAS:

On October 24, 2016, petitioner filed a petition for review of orders issued by respondent Commissioner of Labor; however, copies of the orders were not attached. By letter dated October 24, 2016, pursuant to the Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules) (12 NYCRR) § 66.3, the Board directed petitioner to file an amended petition and a copy of the orders sought to be reviewed in accordance with the Rules. The letter directed petitioner to file an amended petition on or before November 24, 2016, or the petition would be dismissed without further notice. On November 21, 2016, petitioner attempted to file an amended petition, however, the orders were not attached as directed and required by the Rules. By letter dated December 21, 2016, the Board notified petitioner that the amended petition was deficient and that it must submit the orders by January 30, 2017, or the petition would be dismissed.
