Staff are often able to respond to such specific requests more quickly and efficiently than to more general requests.

Records pertaining to civil litigation against or on behalf of the Board.

### **BOARD MEETING RECORDS**

Minutes, agendas, notices, reports, rules and regulations, rulemaking records.

### **CONTRACTS**

Contracts, agreements, memoranda of understanding, and related records.

### **CORPORATE INSTRUMENT PROCEEDINGS**

Applications, decisions, correspondence.

### **FOIL (Freedom of Information Law)**

Requests and responses.

### **NOTICES OF APPEARANCE**

Executive Law Section 166 Notices of Appearance: Filed with the Board by representatives appearing before the Board for a fee.

### **STAYS**

Applications for Stays of Rules, Regulations or Orders.

### **WAGE BOARD**

Petitions, decisions, correspondence, legal briefs, outside counsel correspondence and other related documents.
