WHEREAS:



  - (c) no further hearing herein is necessary.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT


1. The application for a change of corporate name of Union Health Care Coalition Inc. to National Labor Alliance of Health Care Coalitions, Inc. is approved; and
